Issue Report: Memory Issue with WPC Product Bundles for

WooCommerce (Premium)

Issue Description

When the **WPC Product Bundles for WooCommerce (Premium)** plugin is active, the WooCommerce shop page and some other pages fail to load correctly, often resulting in **500/503 errors** or partial page loads. This issue is triggered after product details or category pages are edited in the Wordpress admin panel.

Disabling the plugin resolves the issue, and the pages load correctly, indicating that the problem is isolated to this plugin.

Steps to Reproduce

- 1. Install and activate the **WPC Product Bundles for WooCommerce** plugin.
- 2. Edit product details (e.g., product description, pricing) or edit categories pages.
- Save the changes and navigate to the WooCommerce shop page or categories page.
- 4. Observe that the page fails to load correctly or shows server errors.
